

## Changes to share capital

### Share capital increase following the exercise of stock options

The Board of Directors during its meeting of February 15, 2022 noted that from September 1st, 2021 to December 31, 2021, 417 441 new shares with a par value of 5.50 euros each had been issued pursuant to the exercise of stock options.

As a result, Air Liquide's share capital effective immediately stands at:

**2,614,100,703.50 euros**

Divided into 475,291,037 shares with a par value of 5.50 euros each.
